


(1) Use the Making a **Symmetrical Drawing** instruction sheet to draw a butterfly.

(2) Use scissors to cut around the butterfly.


Making a Fluttering Butterfly

inspired from **Paper Animals in Action by Rob Ives**


(3) Fold a piece of tape over itself to make double sided tape.

Stick this to one side of the clothes peg


as shown.



Fold the wings upwards. This will be the starting point for the movement.




(7)Try it out and see how it flutters. Test out different ways of making the movement smoother and more lifelike.



You will need:

- Paint
- Paintbrush
- Paper
- Scissors
- Tape
- Clothes Peg



Use the tape to stick two strips of paper or cardboard to the middle of the wing and to the bottom of the peg on each side while closed.
