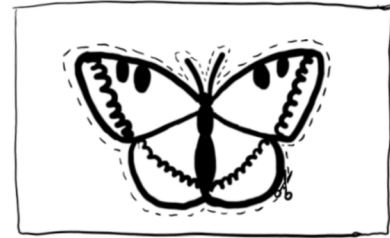


① Use the Making a Symmetrical Drawing instruction sheet to draw a butterfly.

② Use scissors to cut around the butterfly.

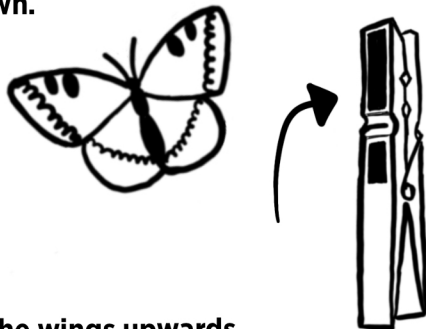


Making a Fluttering Butterfly

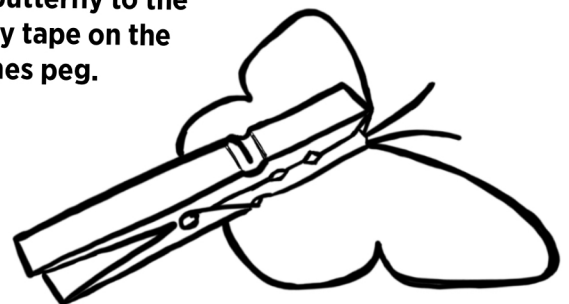

- You will need:**
- Paint
 - Paintbrush
 - Paper
 - Scissors
 - Tape
 - Clothes Peg

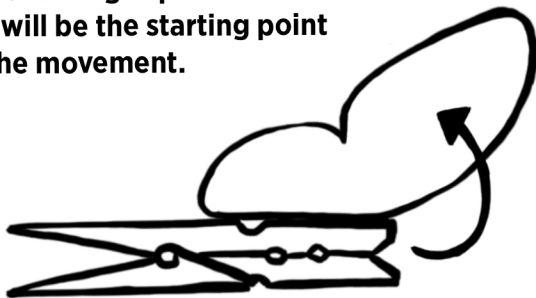
③ Fold a piece of tape over itself to make double sided tape. Stick this to one side of the clothes peg as shown.



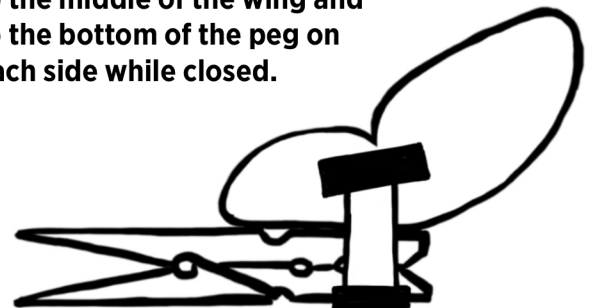
④ Stick the underside of the butterfly to the sticky tape on the clothes peg.



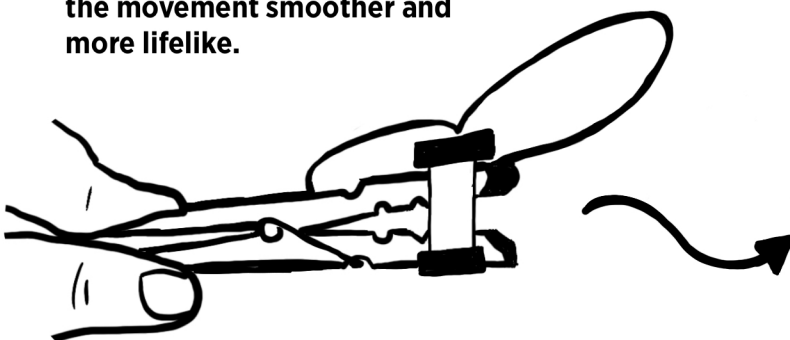
⑤ Fold the wings upwards. This will be the starting point for the movement.



⑥ Use the tape to stick two strips of paper or cardboard to the middle of the wing and to the bottom of the peg on each side while closed.



⑦ Try it out and see how it flutters. Test out different ways of making the movement smoother and more lifelike.
