Għasfur ta' San Martin

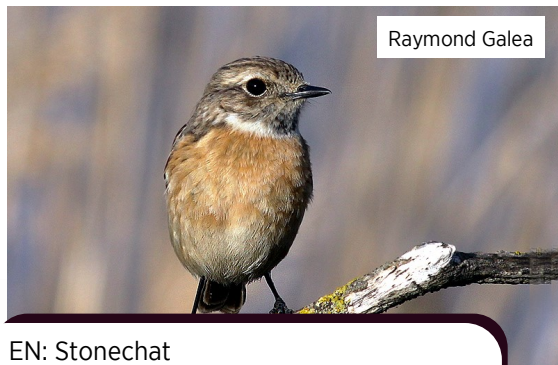


EN: Kingfisher
