- Height: 3.5 metres to 6 metres tall
- The T-rex grew to around 12 metres long. (The length of 3 cars or a very large bus)
- It had 2 legs, and 2 arms that were very tiny compared to the rest of body.
- It was a carnivorous dinosaur, which means that it only ate meat.
- It lived in humid, and semi-tropical temperatures. Think of a very sticky and hot August day in Malta but with a lot more rain.




### **B.** Brachiosaurus

#### **RELATED FACTS**

- Its neck could reach up to 9 metres in length. This means it could reach the roof of Esplora easily with its head.
- Its total body length was around 30 metres.
- The Brachiosaurus had 4 strong legs.
   It had 2 long legs as part of its upper body and 2 shorter legs that were part of its lower part (back).
- They had a very big jaw with spoonshaped teeth, that helped them to pull off the leaves from the top of trees.
   They where herbivores, just like rabbits they only eat plants and leaves.








## C. Pteranodon






- Unlike birds, its wings were not made of feathers, but of skin.
