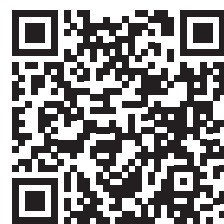

Through play, experimentation, and storytelling, families explore the elements of air, water, earth, and fire, and uncover how each one behaves, interacts, and supports life. From floating bubbles and flowing water to powerful flames and hidden fossils, each experience reveals a different part of the natural world. The programme blends spectacle with hands-on discovery, connecting scientific ideas to everyday life and to the natural environment around us. Designed for different age groups, the experiences encourage curiosity, exploration, and joyful learning across the entire centre.

Interactive Science Show

Science on Fire

Interactive Science Show

Ignite your curiosity with a fiery science show where chemistry meets spectacle. Watch rainbow-coloured flames travel and swirl through the air, while controlled fireballs reveal the secrets of combustion, energy and elemental reactions. This is the science of fire: brilliant, fascinating and brought vividly to life before your eyes in a safe and engaging way.

Water is essential for our lives! However, where does it come from? Join us as we follow a single drop of water on its journey from cloud to tap and back again. Along the way, we will explore the water cycle and discover how the Maltese used science and ingenuity to collect, store and protect water.

Hands-on Workshop

Join a team of young palaeontologists as they uncover dinosaur footprints that may reveal incredible secrets about these ancient creatures. By analysing and observing these tracks, participants will piece together the story of the dinosaurs, discovering how they moved, how large they were and even what they ate.

It's Only Natural

Sensory Play Session

This sensory play session connects children with nature through fabrics and materials inspired by the outdoors. Participants will explore logs, stones, leaves and animal footprints while discovering different shapes, surfaces and patterns that encourage curiosity and appreciation for the natural world.
